General Rules

- 1. Please read general rules and regulations page.
- 2. All exhibitors and their parents/guardians are responsible to read and understand the rules set forth in the Chelsea Community Fair Book. Exhibitors and attendants will comply with the Chelsea Fair Rules and Regulations, the Livestock Exhibition Code of Conduct as well as all rules below.
- Harassment, profanity or unsportsmanlike conduct toward officials, judges, staff, superintendents, other exhibitors, or grounds property will not be tolerated and will result in immediate removal from Fairgrounds.
- 4. Behavior toward any animal which Superintendent deems harsh or inhumane, by exhibitors or guests, will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the Fairgrounds.
- Chelsea Fairground liability waiver must be signed for each exhibitor prior to any riding or lunging. Chelsea Community Fair Management, Superintendents, Judges, and its helpers will not be responsible (individually or collectively) for loss, damage, or injury to any persons, horses, or property incurred in connection with these shows.
- 6. Per Michigan law, a current negative Coggins must be shown to office staff upon arrival.
- 7. Exhibitors may wear a cowboy hat <u>while being judged</u> for a western flat class. **Otherwise**, **All** riders under the age of 18 are required to wear **ASTM**/ **SEI** approved headgear while mounted.
- 8. No stallions allowed.
- 9. Only registered exhibitors may ride on the Fairgrounds.
- 10. No one other than Superintendent, ring steward and show staff may approach the judge(s).
- 11. The only people permitted in the ring during any class will be the exhibitor(s), ring person(s), and official(s) necessary to run the class.
- 12. Exhibitors must clean up after themselves and their horse prior to leaving the fairgrounds. This includes area around the trailer.
- 13. Camping is not available.
- 14. Rules not addressed in the Chelsea Community Fair Premium Book regarding behavior, clothing, equipment, or judging of classes will be governed by the most recent edition of the 4H Horse and Pony Show Rules and Regulations.
- 15. A member or a family member must attend <u>setup and clean up</u>. Failure to do so may result in disqualification from next year's show.

Barn, Stall and Arena Rules

- 1. Barns, stalls and aisleways shall remain clean and clear of obstacles.
- 2. Stall decorating is encouraged but must be tasteful and appropriate. Decorations deemed inappropriate by Superintendent must removed immediately.
- 3. All decorations must be removed prior to haul out.
- 4. Stall must be cleaned prior to haul out this includes stripping of all sawdust.
- 5. It is HIGHLY recommended that any tack stalls be curtained and locked. Exhibitors assume all risk (including damage and loss) associated with leaving items at the Fairground.
- 6. All horses must be stalled by 8 PM unless participating in a class or rodeo.
- 7. Horses are to be exercised in arena only.
- 8. No free lunging is permitted at anytime, anywhere on the grounds.

- 9. Horses may move between the Horse Barn and area directly around the arena. No horses are allowed north of the Horse Barn.
- 10. At no time may a horse go into any area open to the public for the purpose of accessing rides or concessions. Horses are not permitted in any other barns other than the Horse Barn.

Parking, Passes and Hauling In/Out Rules

- 1. Exhibitors may haul-in Wednesday or Thursday, **before** 4pm, or the morning of the show.
- 2. Exhibitors may haul-out at the conclusion of the show or any of the following days **before** 4pm. Horses may remain at the Fairgrounds until Sunday at 9am.
- 3. Exhibitors will be admitted to the fair for each day they are showing.
- 4. Exhibitors who stall a minimum of 2 nights will be eligible for an Exhibitor Pass.
- 5. Vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. Trailers may be dropped along the southern fence if stalling overnight.
- 6. Spectators will need to purchase day passes.

Registration and Class Rules

- 1. Refunds will NOT be given for dropped classes.
- 2. Show staff reserves the right to combine or split any classes.
- 3. Proper riding attire is required at all times, including during warm up.
- 4. Gymkhana riders may wear short sleeves but tank tops are not allowed.
- 5. Participants receiving coaching while in the show ring may be dismissed at the judge's discretion. Coaching is defined as communication of any type to participants in the show ring.
- 6. Gymkhana riders may not run through the gate and must be in control of their horse prior to the start of the pattern.
- 7. The judge has the right to deem an exhibitor unsafe or not in control and excuse the rider from the arena. This is considered a disqualification.
- 8. Refunds will not be issued for class disqualifications.
- 9. Judge's decisions are final.
- 10. Preregistration is preferred but exhibitors may register the morning of the show. See show bill for more information regarding fees.

Exhibitor Age and Division Requirements

- 1. Exhibitor's age is as of 12/31/2022
- 2. Show is open to any rider 18 years old and younger.
- 3. Divisions are defined as:
 - a. Leadline/Walk Only (10 years old & under)
 - b. Walk-Trot (13 years old & under)
 - c. Junior (7-14 years old, W/T/C)
 - d. Senior (15-18 years old, W/T/C)
 - e. Mini: 38" or less (at the last few hairs of the mane)
- 4. Exhibitors who have participated in canter classes at other open shows shall not enter into the Walk-Trot Division without approval from Superintendent.
- 5. Walk-Trot exhibitors may only participate in classes designated as a Walk-Trot class.
- 6. Horse may only enter a class once.
- 7. Rider may only enter a class once.
- 8. Horse/rider combination may only show in one division.
- 9. Leadline/Walk only classes will not be placed but will receive participation ribbons.

High Point and Championship Classes

- 1. High Point participation is optional. Points do not carry over from Rail to Gymkhana. High Point Divisions are defined as:
 - a. Rail Divisions:

i. Walk/Trot: 13 & underii. Junior W/T/C: 7-14 years oldiii. Senior W/T/C: 15-18 years old

- b. Gymkhana Divisions:
 - i. Gymkhana W/T: 13 & under
 - ii. Gymkhana Junior W/T/C: 7-14 years oldiii. Gymkhana Senior W/T/C: 15-18 years old
- 2. Showmanship Championships-first and second place riders from Senior, Junior, Walk/Trot and Minis are eligible to participate in Showmanship Championships. Leadline/Walk Only are not eligible for championship classes.
- 3. Showmanship Championship classes do not count towards Highpoint.
